Shri T. P. Ravindranathan was present to assist the Committee.

The allotment made during the intervening period of AAC-II were presented to the Committee.

(1) Application of Shri Rajkumar K. Gurda, Jr. Tech. Supdt., Chemistry Engg. for change of quarter was discussed. As it transpired that the case was under an inquiry with the Estate Officer and hence a decision on change of quarter was deferred.

(2) The Chairman informed the committee about the items to be forwarded for BOG approval.

(A) Accommodation to Mess servants including Asst. Mess Manager and Mess Manager. On this item regarding accommodation to mess servants, the member- Shri A.G. Kadam- pointed out that there are 199 permanent mess servants for which they have been provided 112 no. of quarters including 30 Type- I quarters from the institute staff accommodation whereas for 1400 Non-Academic staff

members, there are only 844 quarters of various types provided. Hence, the Director may be requested to reconsider this item, especially the waiting list of Type H1 and 2B quarters is around 10-12 years for the institute staff.

(D) The member- Shri A.G. Kadam- requested the committee to reconsider the quantum of debarement as decided in the item no. 05 of 124th meeting of AAC-II and to reduce this to 2 years instead of 3 years. The committee resolved to keep the debarement period as two years instead of one at present.
